3. Fall Festival/Halloween Restrictions for Sex Offenders.


This Rule is effective on and after the 25th day of February, 2016. These provisions will

Fall Festival/Halloween Restrictions for Sex Offenders

As a registered sex offender there are special guidelines that you are required to follow during this particular season. It is also ***your responsibility*** to inform others that reside at your residence of ***your restrictions*** during this time as they may be inadvertently affected.

You will **not** be allowed to participate in any of these events with or without children.

The guidelines are as follows:

1. You are not allowed to place any fall or Halloween decorations either inside or outside of your home.
2. Neither you nor anyone in your home is allowed to answer your door to Trick-or-Treaters. Your porch lights are to be off, drapes/blinds and front doors closed on Trick-or-Treat night.
3. You are not allowed to give any Halloween treats or candy to any children. No treats or candy are to be given out by anyone from your registered place of residence and you are not allowed to visit a residence where treats are being handed out.
4. You are not allowed to wear Halloween costumes.
5. You are not allowed to go with any child to trick-or-treat.
6. You are not allowed to have a Halloween party at your home.
7. You are not allowed to go to corn mazes, haunted houses, hayrides or any other seasonal activity.
8. You are not allowed to be at any function where children are gathered, even if it is a private residence.
9. On the date(s) of _____, your curfew will be _____.

Please keep in mind that these guidelines can also serve as a protection for you, by helping you to avoid situations in which you could be falsely accused or suspected of wrongdoing, or where some may be tempted to re-offend.

The Adult Parole Authority may be making extended announced and unannounced home visits to verify compliance.

Sex Offender Special Conditions

I agree to fully participate in, and successfully complete, the following indicated Sanctions/Special Conditions:

1. You shall register with the Sheriff's Office in your county of residence and your county of employment in accordance with state law.
2. You shall have no contact with the victim(s) of your offense(s), specifically

3. You shall have no contact with co-offenders involved in your sex offense, specifically

4. You shall have no unsupervised contact with minors without the approval of the Adult Parole Authority. The person supervising the contact must be approved by the Adult Parole Authority or the Court.
5. You shall not frequent places where children congregate.
6. You shall not form a relationship with a man or woman who has physical custody of children without the knowledge and permission of the Adult Parole Authority.
7. You shall not possess children's clothing, toys, or games without the knowledge and permission of your supervising officer.
8. You shall not have a Post Office Box without the knowledge and permission of your supervising officer.
9. You shall not possess any binding restraints.
10. You shall not possess any law enforcement identification, insignia, badges, uniforms, or other items associated with law enforcement.
11. You shall inform all persons with whom you have a significant relationship of your offending history.
12. You shall inform your employer of your offending history if instructed to do so by your supervising officer.
13. You shall not use, enter, visit, participate in, or remain in any online chat room, bulletin board service, message board service, news group service, social media site or service, file sharing network or service, or any other online service which provides a means of communication and/or data sharing, with the sole exception of electronic mail.

14. You shall not use any computer or other digital or electronic device or media unless such devices and media are in your home or workplace and unless they are specifically identified to and approved by the Adult Parole Authority in writing.

15. You shall not obtain or use a mobile phone that has internet capabilities and shall not subscribe to or use a service which enables any internet access by television, including online movies or television rentals or subscription services, without the written permission of the Adult Parole Authority.

16. In the event you are approved to use electronic or digital devices by the Adult Parole Authority, you shall disclose to your supervising officer all mobile telephone devices and numbers used by you and all electronic mail accounts, all screen names, all Internet accounts, all internet service providers, and any other means of access to any computer or computer network, and all passwords and access codes.

17. You shall actively participate in and shall successfully complete any and all evaluations, programs, and therapies ordered by the Court or recommended by the Adult Parole Authority, including but not limited to sex offender evaluation or treatment. You shall abide by all rules and recommendations of your treatment provider.

18. You shall not be employed or participate in any volunteer activity where you have contact with children under the age of 18 except under circumstances approved in advance and in writing by the Adult Parole Authority.

19. You shall not disguise or attempt to disguise your identity or your address while accessing any electronic or digital communication device or service or online service.

20. You shall not initiate measures to encrypt any data or any communication in any way.

21. You shall not own or possess any handheld device (e.g. mobile phones, e-readers, I-Pads, I-touch devices, Palm Pilots, Blackberries) that is configured to access and is actively serviced by any online (internet) service, without prior written permission of your supervising officer.

22. You shall not knowingly access, view, inspect, own, obtain, or possess any obscene or sexually explicit visual or auditory material. [Including but not limited to images of nude or partially nude children under the age of eighteen (18)].

23. You shall submit to random, unannounced searches by Law Enforcement officers and/or the Adult Parole Authority of his person, effects, and property, including his computer(s), phones, and of his other digital or electronic devices and media, which may include retrieval and copying of all data from hardware/software and/or removal of such system(s) or devices for the purpose of conducting a more thorough inspection.

24. You shall not permit any other person to use your phone, computer(s), handheld devices, or any related computer, electronic, or digital devices, and is to inform your supervising officer immediately upon learning that any other person has done so.

Conditions of Supervision

As ordered by this Court on the above date, you are to comply with the following general conditions of supervision according to the Washington County Common Pleas Court Rules and you are to obey the rules set forth by your supervising officer. The following terms and conditions shall govern the conduct of every person placed on supervision by Washington County Common Pleas Court.

1. You shall not engage in assaultive, abusive, threatening, intimidating, or destructive behavior.
2. You shall obey all federal, state, and local laws and ordinances.
3. You shall have no contact with the victim of your current offense unless otherwise authorized by the Court.
4. You shall report any arrest, citation for a violation of law, conviction for any offense and all other contact with law enforcement to your supervising officer no later than the next business day. You will not enter into any agreement or other arrangement with any law enforcement agency which might place you in the position of violating any law or condition of your supervision unless you have obtained permission in writing from the sentencing judge.
5. You shall not enter into any bars, carry-outs, or social gatherings where alcohol or illegal drugs are present.
6. You shall not associate with or communicate with any person having a felony conviction, or persons who could influence you to engage in criminal activity, except as expressly permitted by your supervising officer. Exceptions may only be made for family members, employment purposes, or counseling.
7. You shall always keep your supervising officer informed of your residence. You shall not change your residence without first obtaining approval of your supervising officer. You shall remain at your residence from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m. unless otherwise authorized by your supervising officer. Exceptions may be made for employment purposes.
8. You shall regularly seek work or work at a lawful occupation and support your legal dependents, if any, to the best of your ability. You shall notify your supervising officer no later than the next business day if you are fired, laid off or your job otherwise ends. You shall not quit a job or change employment without first having obtained permission from your supervising officer.
9. You shall pay all court ordered financial obligations, when applicable, as directed by your supervising officer.

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10. You shall not leave the county or state without the permission of your supervising officer. You shall obtain a written travel permit from the Adult Parole Authority before leaving the State of Ohio.
11. You shall follow the instructions of your supervising officer or any other authorized representative of the Adult Parole Authority.
12. You shall not purchase, obtain or operate or have under your control a motor vehicle unless you have liability insurance and the approval of your supervising officer.
13. You shall not possess, use, sell, distribute, or have under your control illegal drugs or controlled substances or extracts containing them in any form, nor instruments for administering them except on prescription of a licensed physician. You shall submit to drug testing, at your own expense, if required by the Adult Parole Authority.
14. You shall not purchase, possess, own, use or have under your control, any firearms, ammunition, dangerous ordnance, devices used to immobilize, deadly weapons or any imitation of a weapon. You shall obtain written permission from the Adult Parole Authority prior to residing in a residence where these items are securely located.
15. You shall allow a search of your person, home, vehicle, personal effects, personal property, including without limitation computers, phones, digital or electronic devices and media, without a search warrant, by any law enforcement officer or the Adult Parole Authority.
16. You shall sign a release of confidential information for any public or private agency if requested to do so by the Adult Parole Authority.
17. You shall report to your supervising officer as directed. You shall also report to your supervising officer in person the next business day following any release from custody.
18. Special Conditions, if applicable.

I understand that the Court may change the Conditions of Supervision during my supervision period. As an offender, I can be arrested without a warrant by the Adult Parole Authority, or any other police authority, if directed by the Adult Parole Authority, whenever there are reasonable grounds to believe that I have violated the conditions of my supervision. I have read, or had read to me, the above Conditions of Supervision. I fully understand them and I will abide by them.
