If you live in one of the counties listed below, you may be eligible for our services. You should call SEOLS to find out if you are financially eligible for our services.

You should contact SEOLS when your problem starts, you get court papers, or you are not sure of your legal rights. Even if you have a legal problem that is not listed below, we may be able to give you advice or refer you to another lawyer, agency, or organization for help.

Consumer Rights

Help with a debt collector, a consumer scam, a garnishment, a car repossession, a home improvement problem, a car sales problem, a car repair problem, or if you need to file bankruptcy.

Public Benefits

Issues with benefits for unemployment, OWF, food stamps, VA, SSI, Social Security, Medicaid, Medicare, or other government program that have been denied, stopped, or reduced.

Housing

Assistance if you are being evicted, are locked out, your utilities have been shut off, your landlord will not make needed repairs, your landlord is not following subsidized housing rules, you are being discriminated against, you are facing foreclosure, or if you

Re-Entry

Screening for record sealing and assistance obtaining Certificates of Qualification for Employment (CQE).

Tax

If you owe money to the IRS or have a dispute with the IRS .

Family Problems

If you need protection from domestic violence, a divorce to get free from abuse, assistance with custody issues to help a child get free from abuse, or if you have problems getting child support.

Education

Concerns regarding a child with disabilities or about a school suspension or expulsion.
