Alane Sanders – Consulting for communications

Amanda Bolen OSU Extension – food safety classes and Pax tools, Ohio healthy programs (childcare workers go through to get their professional development points) encourages them to serve healthy breakfast, lunch and snacks.

Shaeleigh Sprigg - Washington County Behavioral Health Board – Working with Linda Sistrunk on data around Suicide ideation and attempt and looking for ways to support those individuals. Also asked that people follow our Facebook page- Recovery is Beautiful for our stigma campaign called “There has to be a better way”.

Sarah Arnold – Washington County Public Library and Clutch MOV – want to increase newsletters, offer to share information and distribute quarterly, have over 10,000 emails on their list.

Mindy Cayton - Buckeye Hills Regional Council - funding related to COVID, CARES Act and Family First funding, purchased ipads for caregivers, access to support groups, facetime with family members/friends, tele-health. Mindy is PPE officer at Buckeye Hills.

Cathy Harper - The Right Path for Washington County – 16th summer of safe teen and family events, we had 3 farmers markets. \$17,000 raised to purchase locally. It was amazing, fresh produce distributed. Shout out to Tara at the board and Heather at GoPacks.

Sam Wallace - Buckeye Hills Regional Council – transportation manager, mobility management program set up in Washington County. Federal and state funding, brought on Brandy Hesson as new mobility manager. Getting that program up and going. Distributing PPE, distributed food, and CARES act funding to support pharmacy and grocery delivery services (expand through mileage reimbursement). Going to distribute mobility survey to identify gaps.

Christine Berg – Community Health Improvement Associates (CHIA)- Onboarding new members for community health workers/american corps/peer recovery supports

Heather Warner, GoPacks – distributed over 28,000 lbs of food this summer. Restructuring programs to accommodate school. Not in the school buildings due to COVID. Weekly contacts with families and are aware of the struggles they are experiencing. New program available for remote learning. Next year hope to be touching kindergarten through 12th grade.

Christie Thomas - Marietta Main Street- Working with Creating Healthy Communities for bike friendly business program, water bottle filler stations

Rebecca Aber Marietta / Belpre Health Department – Introduced herself with the Marietta/Belpre Health Department

Tara Plaughter WCBHB – Recovery Day Event cancelled, we schedule a recovery day walk on Sept 26th at 9AM, start and end at Muskingum Park. Follow Recovery is Beautiful Facebook Page. October PRS training, scaling down to 10 people.
